At Samuel Laycock we offer a Career programme that is cross curricular. This includes Preparation for Adulthood, CV building, interview techniques, application support and Post 16 advice.

### Enrichment

### Work Experience

### Career advice

'Positive Steps', the career adviser service is in school every week and offers advice to parents and pupils around their Post 16 options.

We are a named school with 'Career Connect', a programme to deliver a NEET and prevention of NEET project for year 11.

### College day release.

A number of pupils are offered a 'day release' option at Tameside college, studying a vocational course of their choice and achieving a qualification at the end of the year.
